As the current Lionistic year draws to a close, I would like to express my gratitude to every Lion that has assisted us make this year a great success ...

BrightSight has achieved a lot and grown over the past months but without the buy-in from clubs in the Multiple District, we wouldn't have been able to table a strong report to Multiple District for the year to date!

Some service statistics for this year:

- Scripts from District 410E 1,310
- Scripts from District 410W 283
- Scripts from BrightSight Clinic 1,318
- **Total Scripts processed 2,911**

This represents a total increase of 632 scripts (28%) over the previous year.

Our District School Sight Screening Project (funded by LCIF) got off to a shaky start with delays, exams, load shedding and holidays, but in the end a very successful and noteworthy project was completed:

- Learners Screened 3,369
- Refraction Referrals 490
- Spectacles Issued 284
- Further Treatment Referrals 24

Congratulations to the Top 5 clubs for their support this year. They are:

- Henley on Klip 388 scripts
- Vereeniging 184 scripts
- Klerksdorp 179 scripts
- Alberton 144 scripts
- Knysna 143 scripts

I appeal to those clubs who have not yet tried to get involved in our Sight Projects to give it a go next year.

In order to assist clubs run a successful sight project, two guides are available, namely The School Screening Toolbox and The Community Eye Screening Manual.

These can be downloaded from the Lions BrightSight website or from the Multiple District website.

## ORDERING UPDATE
