A Multiple District 410 Project

Dear Lions,

The management committee is happy to report that we've kicked off a school screening project in the Tshwane District in collaboration with the South African National Council for the Blind.

Spectacles for this project will be supplied by BrightSight. This project was made possible by a \$28,000 grant received from LCIF, roughly R405,000.

Clubs in the area have been asked to participate in the project and we hope to screen 3,300 learners.

Learners identified for further referral will be followed up by the SA National Council of the Blind.

- SANCB will be in regular contact with the District Eye Care Manager who supervises all eye care programmes who will ensure that follow-up care is provided to learners requiring assistance.
- The School Health Nurses will ensure that the learners go for their follow-up testing and receive their spectacles.
- Regular reports will be submitted to SA National Council for the Blind on the progress of the project.

OCTOBER 2021 WHITE CANE DAY PROJECT



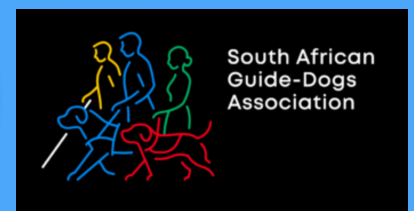
This year, Lions BrightSight is collaborating with the SA Guide-Dogs Association in raising awareness of sight health and raising funds to help those in our communities that are visually impaired.

A portion of the profit from every Pin sold this year will be donated to the Association to be used specifically to purchase folding canes. These canes as well as the training required to use them safely, will be donated to their clients in the communities around Gauteng. The Association will also be marketing and selling Pins to their partner base.

Packets of 100 Pins are available for R750 per packet to Clubs and Business Partners. R250 of the proceeds of each packet sold, will be donated directly to the Association.

The suggested retail price to the public is R10.00 per Pin.

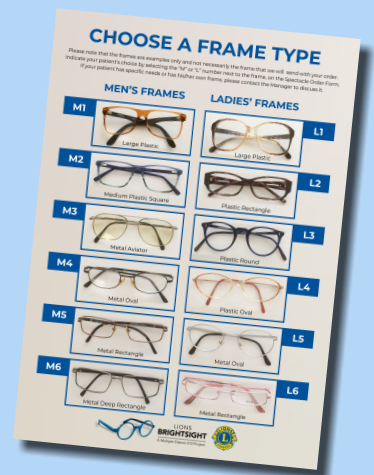

ORDERING UPDATE

In order to assist Clubs select frames for their patients, we have added a frame selection page to our site as well as a second page to the downloadable Club Script Order Form.
