Fellow Lions,

Just a quick, friendly reminder that October is Sight Month. During October, Lions throughout the world normally observe World Sight Day on 12 October and White Cane Safety Day on 15 October. At BrightSight, however, we consider the whole of October as Sight Month!

National White Cane Safety Day

on 15 October celebrates the achievements of people who are blind or visually impaired. The day marks the importance of recognizing the white cane. The white cane is not only a tool. It also represents the independence for those who are visually impaired, world wide.

This year, we are once again, observing white Cane Day for the whole of October to raise funds for the College of Orientation & Mobility, a division of the SA Guide Dog Association.

Our goal is to provide funding to the College of Orientation & Mobility to enable them to aquire white canes, liquid level indicators and money identifiers. The funds will also be used to offer training sessions for visually impaired persons.

The Orientation & Mobility Department plays two major roles in assiting visually impaired people:

• Orientation & Mobility Support

Our Orientation & Mobility practitioners provide long cane, visual skills and daily living skills training to children and adults with visual impairment, at no cost. They also provide visual impairment awareness training to a range of audiences.

Training of Orientation & Mobility Support Practitioners

These trained practitioners, in turn, teach visually impaired people valuble cane and daily living skills to make them more independent and mobile.

So how can your Club help raise funds, to give a vision impaired person the opportunity for independence?

Easy, just sell White Cane Day Pins and donate the profits to the College of Orientation & Mobility at the SA Guide Dog Association!
